



Uniform Guidance

The school uniform at Crawford Village Primary School consists of:

Reception – Year 6

- a navy v-neck **knitted** sweater or cardigan embroidered with the school logo
- white collared shirt (not a polo shirt / collared t-shirt)
- tie (clip-on or full tie)
- **grey** trousers or a **grey** skirt / pinafore dress
- white or grey socks or grey tights
- a blue gingham dress in the summer months* with white socks (optional summer uniform)
- grey shorts (optional summer* uniform)
**after the Easter holidays until October half-term.*

Nursery

- school uniform as above **OR** yellow polo shirt & navy sweatshirt/sweat cardigan with school logo, plus any comfortable trousers/skirt

Items of uniform embroidered with the school logo and school ties are available to order via the School Trends website. (www.schooltrends.co.uk)

Footwear should be black school shoes, not trainers or boots.

Hair should be tied back if it is shoulder length or longer, using sensible hair bobbles or clips. Hair decorations (e.g. flowers or decorative hair bands) should not be worn. No jewellery should be worn except for plain, small stud ear-rings and a watch (optional).

For PE, children need trainers or pumps that can be managed independently. Our PE kit consists of white t-shirt embroidered with the school logo and navy blue PE shorts. In winter, children should wear a navy hooded sweatshirt and joggers (these are also available via School Trends website).

As our learning environment is both indoors and outdoors, we ask that you make sure your child is equipped for these areas at all times of year. Please ensure their clothing is practical and suitable for the seasonal changes. Waterproof jackets and winter clothing for cold weather and a sun hat in the summer months. Children may bring sun cream into school during hot weather and apply it themselves during the day.

Please ensure that all items of children's uniform and belongings are labelled clearly with their name.
