British Science Week at Crawford

Last week, we celebrated British Science Week 2021, and what a week it was! We began the week by welcoming all the children back before they had to complete an escape rooms task, whereby the children had to answer a series of science questions to gain the code needed to unlock mysterious boxes found in their classrooms. Much to the excitement of everyone, they were jam packed with treats!



We then created fantastic STEM posters, based around 'Classrooms of the Future' and 'Smashing Gender Stereotypes'. Oliver W and Henry (Class 2) and Lucy M, Zac R and Isla's (Class 3) posters have been chosen to represent our school in the British Science Association official competition.

Class 1 used their scientific skills to observe the changes happening around us as Spring starts to appear. They have also watched how materials change as they baked some delicious cookies. Class 2 and 3 joined a live YouTube session with Theeb the Vet – we were shown how cows are looked after at the cattle farm and learned all about their nutritional and environmental needs. We then compared their heart rates, breaths per minute and eyes to our own. Class 3 have also been investigating light and space, creating their own periscopes and spectroscopes and creating videos to send to NASA all about space!

Finally, a huge well done to Isla and Henry who displayed creative thinking, curiosity and fantastic science knowledge throughout the week, and who we crowned our Scientists of the Month.
