Key facts

- Zambia is a country in southern Africa.
- Zambia has a tropical climate, so it is warm for most of the year. There is a dry season and a wet season.
- There are many national parks in Zambia where the government protects the land and its wildlife.

Key vocabulary

- Equator: an invisible line that runs around the centre of the earth
- Physical features: natural geography that would be here even if there were no people around e.g. seas, mountains and rivers.
- **Human features**: features built by people such as houses, roads and bridges.
- Crops: plants that are grown to be used or sold.
- **Population**: the number of people that are living in a place.
- Wildlife: the wild animals and plants in an area.
