- Sequence events according to their significance for groups of people.
- Find evidence and make inferences from sources.
- Name Viking trade routes.
- Explain why trade routes were important to the Vikings.
- Identify the differences between Viking sagas.
- Evaluate the impact of Viking achievements.

# <u>Computing – Unit 4.4 Writing for</u> different audiences

- To explore how font size and style can affect the impact of a text.
- To use a simulated scenario to produce a news report.
- To use a simulated scenario to write for a community campaign.

# <u>Science - Environment - Classification.</u>

Throughout this unit the children will:

- Sort animals into groups based on their similarities and differences.
- Learn about the standard system of classification first developed by Carl Linnaeus, choosing an animal and researching its classification.
- Design and create their own 'curious creature' and classify it based on its characteristics.
- Learn about micro-organisms, and conduct an investigation into the growth of mould on bread.
   Furthermore, the children will
- Use play dough to create a new single celled micro-organism and explain how it is classified and why.
- Create a field guide to the living things in their local area, showing how and why each one is classified.

# Art - Sculpture and 3D: Mega materials.

Throughout this unit of work children will:

- Develop ideas for 3D work through drawing and visualisation in 2D.
- Use more complex techniques to shape materials (create a soap sculpture)
- Explore how shapes can be formed and joined in wire.
- Consider the effect of how sculpture is displayed using shadows.
- Choose and join a variety of materials to make sculpture using a variety of techniques we have learnt about throughout the half term.

# <u>Music – Inter-related dimensions of</u> music.

In this theme, children are going to become musical super sleuths and will be quizzed on their knowledge of music so far. Children will explore:

- Instruments and their families.
- Dynamics and duration.
- Timbre.
- Melody.
- Pitch.
- Different genres.
