Key vocabulary

- Historical vocabulary: past, present, today, tomorrow, future, years ago, timeline, order, before, after
- Chronology: the order in which things happen
- **Source:** Something that gives us information about the past.
- Evidence: The information historians take from sources.
- Similar: Something that is like something else alike but not identical.
- Different: Something that is not like something else.
- Change: To make different.
