- Times tables are of vital importance in all aspects of maths work in school. Please encourage your child to access games on the TT Rockstars (Y2+) and 'numbots' website to help their rapid recall of multiplication and division facts related to times tables.
- In addition to the daily maths lesson, all children in Years 1 & 2 access a 15 minute 'Mastering Number' session which focuses on developing 'Number sense' and 'fluency'.

Ballads

- Identify the key features of a ballad.
- Perform a ballad using actions.
- Sing in time and in tune with a song.
- Retell a summary of an animation's story.
- Begin to create lyrics that match a melody.
- Recognise and explain changes within a piece of music using musical vocabulary.

English

- Y1 & Y2 – Animal adventure stories and Letters.
 - Y3 – Explanations, Fantasy and Film and Play scripts.
 - Y1 – Extend range of joining words to link words and clauses using but and or.
 - Y2 – Use apostrophes for contracted forms and singular possession in nouns, use the suffix -ly to turn adjectives into adverbs and effectively use adverbs and verbs.
 - Y3 – Use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech and understand Standard English correct verb forms for singular and plural subjects e.g. I was, he/she/it was, we were, they were.
- In addition to the daily English lesson, Year 1 and 2 have daily phonics sessions.
- Year 3 follows a focused spelling programme which is based on a two weekly cycle.
- Years 2 & 3 will also have a daily Reading session focusing on vocabulary and comprehension skills.
