#### Maths

Year 4 will focus their learning on decimals and time.
Year 5 will focus their learning on decimals and percentages, money and properties of shape.
Year 6 will focus their learning on statistics, geometry and area.
Both Years 5 and 6 will also continue with daily arithmetic.



#### Music

The children will learn how to compose their own graphic notation. They will then use their knowledge to compose and perform an Amazon Adventure listening and memory game using their choice of notation.

# Design & Technology

#### **Textiles**

The children will create a textile product for a stated purpose and user through an iterative process.

## <u>Science</u> Observing Life Cycles

- Describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.
- Describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.
- Plants produce pollen from the stamen (male part of the plant) which is transferred to the stigma and then the ovary (female parts of the plant).
- Fertilisation occurs in the ovary of the flower.
- Seeds are formed as a result of fertilisation.

# <u>Geography</u>

In this topic, children will learn about the Amazon Basin. They will learn about the tropical rainforest covering the area and other rainforests of the world. They will then start to learn how the future of rainforests and other ecosystems are closely connected to human lives and lifestyles.



### **English**



This half term, we will be investigating stories from other cultures. We will write our own narrative following a similar theme. We will also investigate the language and layout features of persuasive speeches; we will be conducting a class debate using our speeches.

There will be short writing opportunities in the form of emotion grids, thought bubbles and character descriptions. In grammar, we will be exploring modal verbs, adverbials, inverted commas and separating independent clauses with semicolons and colons. In reading, we will be focussing on inference and deductive reasoning skills.

## <u>RE</u>

The children will explore the themes of the Bible and identify familiar stories, including the parables of Jesus.
