- Times tables are of vital importance in all aspects of maths work in school. Please encourage your child to access games on the TT Rockstars (Y2+) and 'numbots' website to help their rapid recall of multiplication and division facts related to times tables.
- In addition to the daily maths lesson, all children in Years 1 & 2 access a 15 minute 'Mastering Number' session which focuses on developing 'Number sense' and 'fluency'.

Leaders and Teachers

- Understand what a leader is and why leaders are important.
- Find out about different world leaders and their special books.

Geography

- Name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.
- Identify hot and cold places and locate them on a map.
- Recognise the features of a hot and a cold place.
- Identify the animals that live in hot and cold places and recognise how they adapt.

Music

- Begin to recognise the basic style indicators of Reggae music.
- After listening to music, talk about the songs using correct musical language.

Science

- What makes an animal an animal?
- Identify and name common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals.
- Identify and name a variety of animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Recognise similarities and differences between animals.
- Recognise that animals need to be treated with care and sensitivity to keep them alive and healthy.

Computing

- Log in safely to Purple Mash and understand why it is important.
- Create an avatar and understand why they are used.
- Start to understand the idea of ownership of creative work, where to save work and how to find it again.
- Become familiar with resources and the Tools area on Purple Mash.
- Understand terminology associated with the internet and searching.
- Gain better understanding of searching the internet.

English

- Y1 & Y2 – Stories by the same author and non-chronological reports.
 - Y3 – Mystery stories, explanations and classic poetry.
 - Y1 – Say, hold in memory and write simple sentences; separate words with spaces; use punctuation to demarcate simple sentences.
 - Y2 – Secure the use of full stops and capital letters.
 - Y3 – Simple sentences punctuated correctly; understand nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs; identify, select and effectively use personal pronouns.
- In addition to the daily English lesson, Year 1 and 2 have daily phonics sessions.
- Year 3 follows a focused spelling programme which is based on a two weekly cycle.
 - Years 2 & 3 will also have a daily Reading session focusing on vocabulary and comprehension skills.
 - A short daily handwriting session.
