Key facts

- A continent is one of Earth's seven main divisions of land. The continents are, from largest to smallest: Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe, and Australia.
- In the east, the Ural Mountains separate Europe from Asia. The nations of Russia and Kazakhstan straddle both continents.
- Qatar is a Muslim estate where Islamic culture is followed in daily life.
- Qatar has a desert climate with sunshine, extreme summers, and mild winters.

Key vocabulary

- **Continent:** One of Earth's seven main divisions of land.
- **Country:** An area of land controlled by a single government.
- **Capital City:** Where a region's government is located.
- **Climate Zone:** An area with a distinct climate.
- **Biome:** an area classified according to the species that live in that location.
- **Vegetation Belt:** A vegetation belt is an area with distinct plant types, determined by climate, soil, drainage and elevation.
- **River:** a ribbon-like body of water that flows downhill from the force of gravity.
- **Mountain:** a landform that rises at least 1,000 feet (300 meters) or more above its surrounding area.
- **Volcano:** an opening in the Earth's crust through which lava, ash, and gases erupt.
- **Earthquake:** the ground shaking.
- **Settlement:** Where people live.
- **Latitude:** Horizontal line that is the measurement of distance north or south of the Equator.
- **Longitude:** Vertical lines that is the measurement east or west of the prime meridian
